**Ready to take it to the next level?** And come someplace beautiful in the process? How great is that?

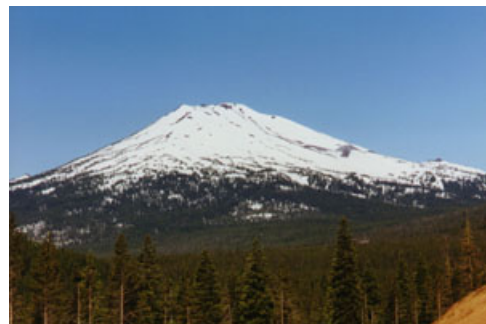
